**Target Audience:** The target audience\* for this course includes, but is not limited to:

- Teachers, administrators, school staff, district staff, elected officials, school board members, transportation coordinators, safety professionals.
- Members of the emergency management and response community, including but not limited to: Community planners, fire representatives, law enforcement, and public works personnel.
- Risk managers and/or insurance representatives.

**Course Objectives:** This course will teach participants how to:

1. Plan for and recover from school critical incidents and emergencies. Use the foundations of emergency management information in creating their plan and incorporate this understanding into subsequent learning.
2. Analyze the school environment with an emergency management perspective.
3. Incorporate the incident management method, specifically the Incident Command System or Incident Management System, into their emergency management plan.
4. Create or revise a school emergency management plan using the planning process.
5. Identify the people and agencies that should be involved in the planning process.
6. Conduct a hazard and vulnerability analysis of their school or district.
