Teachers should **APPLY NOW for APSI Scholarships** with individual APSI Institutes.

Scholarships cover registration, fees (if applicable), travel reimbursement up to \$500, and stipends up to \$250 based on the number of days of the institute and completion of the institute. Scholarships are limited to teachers who work in the Partnership designated high schools and middle schools. For a list of designated schools or information about scholarships, teachers may contact the institute directors or Debbie Shepard at dshepard@collegeboard.org.

PLEASE NOTE: Early submissions for stipend or travel reimbursement are NOT accepted. Following your institute, a copy of your certificate of Institute attendance must be attached to your request, as well as your completed W-9 form.
