*** Waivers for Allocations Under \$15,000**

Section 131(c) (2) (A) (B), Secondary Career and Technical Education Programs, eligible institutions with an allocation of less than \$15,000 must either:

- enter into a consortium (see **Consortium Requirements** section), or;
- request a waiver based on being located in a rural, sparsely populated area, and an inability to enter into a consortium.
