New Postsecondary Administrator Training
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Florida's Perkins IV State Plan- **Accountability**

Postsecondary Level- College Credit

- **Participants** –A postsecondary/adult student who has earned one (1) or more credits in any college credit career and technical education program.
- **Concentrators** –A postsecondary student who completes at least one-third of the academic and/or technical hours in a college credit career and technical education program that terminates in the award of an industry recognized credential, certificate or degree.

Accountability – College Credit

Technical Skill Attainment (1P1)

% CTE concentrators who completed a technical skill assessment (gold) or who earned 75 percent of program hours with a GPA of 2.5 or higher (bronze)

2007-08 ACTUAL: 42.6%

2008-09 TARGET: 37.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 40.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who 1) earned 75 percent of the program hours required with a grade point average of 2.5 or higher or 2) earned an industry certified credential through a third party assessment.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators during the reporting year.

Accountability – College Credit

Student Completion (2P1)

% CTE concentrator leavers who received a certificate
or degree

2007-08 ACTUAL: 48.5%

2008-09 TARGET: 28.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 37.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who received an industry-recognized credential, a certificate, or a degree during the reporting year.

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Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who left during the reporting year.

Accountability – College Credit

Student retention (3P1)

% CTE concentrators from the prior year without a certificate or degree who remained enrolled in postsecondary education

2007-08 ACTUAL: 72.5%

2008-09 TARGET: 72.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 75.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who remained enrolled in their original institution or transferred to another 2- or 4-year postsecondary institution and who were enrolled in postsecondary education in the previous reporting year.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who did not earn an industry-recognized credential, a certificate, or a degree in the previous reporting year.

Student placement (4P1)

**% CTE concentrator completers from the prior year
who were employed, continuing their education, or
in the military**

2007-08 ACTUAL: 86.0%

2008-09 TARGET: 86.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 87.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators from the prior year who received a credential, degree or certificate who were placed in postsecondary education, employment and/or military service in the 2nd quarter (October-December) after leaving postsecondary education.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators from the prior year who received a credential, degree or certificate. (Only students in the prior year 2P1 numerator who have a valid social security number.)

Accountability – College Credit

Student participation in and completion of CTE programs that lead to nontraditional fields. (5P1, 5P2)

% of CTE participants in nontraditional programs who were from underrepresented gender groups

2007-08 ACTUAL: 13.1%

2008-09 TARGET: 13.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 14.0%

5P1 Numerator: Number of CTE participants from underrepresented gender groups in college credit programs that lead to employment in nontraditional fields during the reporting year.

Denominator: Number of CTE participants in college credit programs that lead to employment in nontraditional fields during the reporting year.

% non-traditional CTE concentrators who received a certificate or degree

2007-08 ACTUAL: 34.5%

2008-09 TARGET: 22.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 22.5%

5P2 Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who received an industry-recognized credential, certificate, or degree in college credit programs identified as non-traditional for their gender.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators in college credit programs identified as non-traditional for their gender.

Adult Level- Clock Hours

- **Participants** –A postsecondary/adult student who has earned one (1) or more credits in any clock hour career and technical education program.
- **Concentrators** –A postsecondary student who completes at least one-third of the academic and/or technical hours in a clock hour career and technical education program that terminates in the award of an industry recognized credential, certificate or degree.

Accountability – Certificate (PSAV)

Technical Skill Attainment (1A1)

% CTE concentrators who passed an approved technical skill assessment test (gold level) or who completed an OCP (bronze)

2007-08 ACTUAL: 73.1%

2008-09 TARGET: 73.25%

2009-10 TARGET: 74.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who 1) achieved at least one occupational completion point (OCP) in a Vocational Certificate (PSAV) program or 2) earned an industry certified credential through a third party assessment.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators during the reporting year.

Accountability – Certificate (PSAV)

Student Completion (2A1)

% CTE concentrator leavers who received a certificate

2007-08 ACTUAL: 51.1%

2008-09 TARGET: 51.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 54.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who received an industry-recognized credential or a certificate during the reporting year.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who left during the reporting year.

Accountability – Certificate (PSAV)

Student retention (3A1)

% CTE concentrators from the prior year without a certificate who remained enrolled in postsecondary education

2007-08 ACTUAL: 48.4%

2008-09 TARGET: 55.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 56.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who remained enrolled in their original institution or transferred to another 2- or 4-year postsecondary institution and who were enrolled in postsecondary education in the previous reporting year.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators who did not earn an industry-recognized credential or a certificate in the previous reporting year.

Accountability – Certificate (PSAV)

Student placement (4A1)

% CTE concentrator completers from the prior year who were employed, continuing their education, or in the military

2007-08 ACTUAL: 81.1%

2008-09 TARGET: 82.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 83.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators from the prior year who received a credential or certificate who were placed in postsecondary education, employment and/or military service in the 2nd quarter (October-December) after leaving postsecondary education.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators from the prior year who received a credential or certificate. (Only students in the prior year 2A1 numerator who have a valid social security number.)

Accountability – Certificate (PSAV)

Student participation in and completion of CTE programs that lead to nontraditional fields.
(5A1,5A2)

% of CTE participants in nontraditional programs who were from underrepresented gender groups

2007-08 ACTUAL: 8.7%

2008-09 TARGET: 8.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 9.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE participants from underrepresented gender groups in clock hour programs that lead to employment in nontraditional fields during the reporting year.

Denominator: Number of CTE participants in clock hour programs that lead to employment in nontraditional fields during the reporting year.

% non-traditional CTE concentrators who received a certificate

2007-08 ACTUAL: 43.5%

2008-09 TARGET: 12.0%

2009-10 TARGET: 13.0%

Numerator: Number of CTE concentrators who received an industry-recognized credential or certificate in clock hour programs identified as non-traditional for their gender.

Denominator: Number of CTE concentrators in certificate (clock hour) programs identified as non-traditional for their gender.
