Validated Occupational Completion Point and Literacy Completion Point students received in 2004-2005 are included in the completion counts. Students with valid 2003-2004 completions found employed in 2004-2005 have the placement points distributed across Fund Types (e.g. (PSAV, ABE, VESOL, etc.) in which the student was reported as a completion point. Each Fund Type is included once in the count.

Performance Points are calculated based on weighting completion points, placement levels, and targeted student attributes. These attributes include: having a disability; participating in Welfare-to-Work programs; Workforce Incentive Act adults and older youths/dislocated workers programs.
