Also, students saw the importance of attending school and being ready to learn. Our counselors were excited about the program and their enthusiasm transferred to students and staff alike. I was thrilled to see the results of the program. We had a 25% decrease in tardies and a 39% decrease in absenteeism. Furthermore, there was a direct correlation between student attendance and reading achievement. Wow! My hope is that the Breakfast Club can continue for the 2007-2008 school year.
