Data after action plan:

4th Grade FCAT Results:

Increased an average of 41 points in Math.

Increased an average of 14 points in Reading.

5th Grade FCAT Results:

Increased an average of 18 points in Math.

Increased an average of 26 points in Reading.

Principal's Comments

Systemic Changes

As indicated by our attendance data, we saw an average increase in the number of days missed by students when comparing the end of the 2005/06 school year to the 2006/07 school year.

We plan on implementing a Renaissance school –wide program next year that focuses on academic, behavioral, and attendance improvements to address this concern.

- Continue to expand ability grouping for reading.
- FCAT prep courses for students.
- FCAT parenting classes.
- Weekly Professional Learning Communities.
- Tutoring for struggling students 3-5.
- Guidance lessons focusing on conflict resolution, stress management, study skills, and team building.

School improvement Issues

- The number of students scoring at or above a level 3 on FCAT should be increased.
- Reading and math proficiency should be increased for 3rd grade students
- Establish a school-wide Renaissance program.
- Increase parent involvement.
- Grow the LINKS program by recruiting more mentors for students.
