EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Section 1011.6202, F.S., created by HB 287 (2016), establishes the Principal Autonomy Pilot Program Initiative and authorizes the State Board to enter into a performance contract with school districts that exchange many statutory and rule exemptions for an agreement to meet performance goals.

Three school districts (Broward County, Palm Beach County, and Pinellas County) have elected to participate in the initiative, and have submitted phase two of their applications for the Board's approval. Phase two applications highlight whether the current principal assigned is being retained; provides assurances for requirements and deliverables; and includes descriptions of each school's leadership, current financial and administrative management, and strategic goals and targets.
