Frequently Asked Questions and Answers

PCOG Applications must be emailed to CTEGRANT@fldoe.org by July 15, 2022 at 5PM (EDT)

A mandatory [Notice-of-Intent-to-Apply](#) must be submitted by July 15, 2022 at 5PM (EDT)

Question #1: The Program Components tab is blank, what should I do?

Answer #1: The applicant must first make a selection of “Apprenticeship” or “Preapprenticeship” on question number 1a of the General Program Information tab.

Question #2: How do I find the SOC Codes?

Answer #2: SOC Codes can be found here, www.bls.gov/oes.

Question #3: I’m not sure how to fill out the DOE-610/620, what do I do?

Answer #3: If your application is approved for PCOG funding, you will work with the DOE Finance Department to complete the necessary paperwork for grant funding.

Question #4: How much funding can I apply for?

Question #5: There is no minimum or maximum amount of funding limit.

Question #6: Some of the questions appear cut-off on the application. What should I do?

Answer #6: Send your application to Charles.Feehrer@fldoe.org and I will correct the formatting.

Question #7: How do I know what region I’m in?

Answer #7: Please refer to the Request for Proposal (pg. 18).

Question #8: Can I review awarded PCOG applications?

Answer #8: Yes. PCOG applications are public records. Simply request which application(s) you’d like to see.

Question #9: When is the application due?

Answer #9: The RFP states the Pathways to Career Opportunities grant application is due by **5PM (EDT) Friday, July 15, 2022** to CTEGRANT@fldoe.org.
