


Section 413.615, Florida Statute Florida Endowment for Vocational Rehabilitation

- Legislative Intent: The Legislature recognizes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of this state that citizens with disabilities be afforded a fair opportunity to become self-supporting, productive members of society.
- Created as a direct-support organization of the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation, to encourage public and private support to enhance vocational rehabilitation and employment of citizens who are disabled.



Timeline




Able Trust (AT) Created AT Board Vote & Via Sec. 413.615, F.S. Statute Updates

Allowing AT transfer all private funds and endowments to a nonprofit. Legislation passed required separate accounting and 15% limit on administrative expenses

Sept. 19, 2019

ACF agrees to terms outlined to comply with an audit, dissolve, and transfer all funds back



Dec. 31, 2019

ACF will cease day-today operations and legally dissolve

Aug. 16, 2019

FDOE started working with AT staff and Board Chair Karen Moore to successfully meet items listed out on the DSO report letter



Aug. 29, 2019

AT updates all fiscal accounts to leadership adjustment and freezes all financial accounts



Oct. 31, 2019

ACF will transfer all funds back to AT
