Consideration of Cycle 1, Year 1 Turnaround Option Plans for Approval

**AUTHORITY FOR STATE BOARD ACTION**

Section 1008.33, Florida Statutes

**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

This action item is for the approval of turnaround option plans regarding schools in their first year of implementation during the 2019-20 school year. The submitted plans represent 23 schools in 14 districts, each of which has earned a single grade of F or two consecutive low-performing grades. Districts selected district-managed turnaround for 22 schools and closure for one school. These schools are in the first cycle of turnaround and will receive Tier 2 support from the Department as defined in Rule 6A-1.099811, F.A.C. The district must immediately implement intervention and support strategies prescribed in s. 1088.33(3)(c), F.S.

Upon approval, the district will implement the district-managed turnaround plan for two years unless the school improves to a C grade or higher. At the end of the implementation period, those districts whose schools have not improved to a C grade or higher, will present a new turnaround option plan to the State Board of Education for consideration. There is one district which selected the closure turnaround option.
