**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Pursuant to Rule 6A-1.099811(11)(b), a school district may choose to enter a Turnaround Option Plan- External Operator (EO), with State Board approval set forth in paragraph (7)(b). The EO is the option through which the district contracts with an outside entity that has a record of effectiveness to operate the school. The school district shall enter into an annual contract with the EO, set forth in subparagraph (11)(b)(5).

Hillsborough has four schools that require an updated turnaround plan and annual external operator contract due to the proposed change in External Operator:

- Folsom Elementary School
- Foster Elementary School
- McDonald Elementary School
- Oak Park Elementary School
