Required Instruction Rules

There are four rules that directly pertain to implementation of the required instruction in s. 1003.42(2), F.S.

- 6A-1.094124, F.A.C., Required Instruction Reporting
- 6A-1.094121, F.A.C., Mental and Emotional Health Education
- 6A-1.094122, F.A.C., Substance Use and Abuse Health Education
- 6A-1.094123, F.A.C., Child Trafficking Prevention Education

Today's Action Item

- Consolidates the three health rules (6A-1.094121, 6A-1.094122 and 6A-1.094123) into Rule 6A-1.094124.
 - These three health rules are then repealed.
- Mandates the Required Instruction Reporting Portal for district submission of annual plans and reports.
- Provides the Department with authority to notify districts of reported sections that do not meet the rule and obtain revisions.
 - Districts will have no fewer than 45 days to submit revisions.
- Allows the Department to provide technical assistance.
