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Purpose of Rule

- The benefits of the proposed rule will be enhancement of health and safety due to greater accountability by school districts and public schools.
- Provides school districts, including charters, with notice of the Office of Safe Schools' (OSS) requirements relating to school safety and procedures for monitoring and addressing issues of suspected noncompliance with safety requirements, including required reporting and training.
- Sets forth requirements relating to school safety and to define certain safety measures that schools are expected to meet.
- Provides a useful tool for all involved in implementing or overseeing school safety and outline what the requirements and responsibilities are for OSS, school districts, and public schools.

Expectations & Requirements Outlined in the Rule

Role of the Office of Safe Schools (OSS)

- Responsible for monitoring school districts and public schools, including public charter schools, for compliance with school safety statutes and rules
- Provide notice of suspected deficiencies to SSS, and required corrective actions
- Verify compliance or correction of suspected deficiencies

Role of the District School Safety Specialist (SSS)

- Responsible for supervision and oversight for all school safety and security personnel, policies and procedures in the school district, including at public charter schools
- Serve as the point of contact between FDOE and the school district regarding any compliance concerns
- Facilitate cooperation and communication with schools to address areas of concern

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
