EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The rule amendment reflects the updates to s. 1003.5716, F.S., during the 2021 Legislative Session and Rule 6A-1.0943, Statewide Assessment for Students with Disabilities. This amendment modifies the notification process of deferment of a standard high school diploma to start prior to the beginning of the school year in which the student is expected to meet the graduation requirements. In addition, the understanding and identification of deferment must be included on the student's individual educational plan.
