**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

In accordance with s. 1008.22(7), Florida Statutes (F.S.), the Commissioner of Education is required to publish on the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) website a uniform assessment calendar, using the template incorporated as part of this Rule, for the following two school years by January 1 of each year. Districts are then required to add district-level assessment information and publish their district uniform assessment calendar for the following year by October 1 of each year.

The purpose of this proposed amendment is to revise the uniform assessment calendar template so its format is better streamlined for FDOE and districts to annually populate with the most current testing and policy information.

Numerous changes passed during the 2021 Legislative Session require the content incorporated in the adopted template to be revised to reflect new testing legislation. The template is being streamlined as part of this update.
