**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The rule amendment reflects the updates of s. 1003.5716, F.S., during the 2021 Legislative Session. The effect will amend the transition process to postsecondary education and career opportunities for students with disabilities during the student's seventh grade year or age 12, whichever occurs first, rather than at age 14, and have an operational plan in place that is implemented on the first day of the student's first year in high school.
