Definitions

Living Situations

Sheltered: Living in emergency or transitional shelters, FEMA Trailers, abandoned in hospitals.

Shared Housing: Sharing the housing of other persons due to loss of housing, economic hardship or a similar reason; doubledup.

Other: Living in cars, parks, temporary trailer parks or campgrounds due to lack of alternative adequate accommodations, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings or similar settings.

Motel: Living in hotels or motels.

Unaccompanied Homeless Youth

A homeless youth (or student eligible for homeless services) who is not in the physical custody of a parent or guardian.
