Staffing Compliance and Supports



- All state board conditions have been met
- School and district implemented all BSI field team recommendations
- Collaborative relationship with school, district, and BSI field team to proactively identify and find solutions for barriers that would have a negative impact on student achievement and growth
- Content specific teacher “bench” positions were created to support small group and whole group instruction and to step in for teacher absences

Charter Schools USA Partnership



- The district has been involved in ongoing communication with Charter Schools USA in regards to Warrington Middle dating back to March 2021
- In the event Warrington Middle receives a grade below a C, Escambia County will enter into a contract with Charter Schools USA for Warrington Middle to convert to a full charter school during the 2023-2024 school year
- The district is committed to pursuing ongoing consultation with Charter Schools USA regarding systems and daily operations for the 2022-2023 school year

Rationale for Transition Year with Charter School USA Consultancy



- Charter Schools USA preparation timeline request (6+ months)
 - System changes (Handover from district to charter)
 - Hiring of administration, faculty, and staff
 - Charter Schools USA will require an adequate timeline to hire a new administrative team, faculty, and staff for the 2023-2024 school year
 - Final decision on school model (K-8 vs. feeder elementary schools)
 - Facility changes (possible conversion to K-8)
- Transition year will allow for adequate time to communicate with parents regarding the transition and all of their options for the 2023-2024 school year.
- Impact on Escambia County students if Warrington is closed
 - Bussing (30+ minutes)
 - Student enrollment and capacity issues at receiving middle schools
