EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The amendment to Rule 6A-1.0018, F.A.C., will set forth procedures utilized by the Office of Safe Schools to monitor school districts and public schools for compliance with requirements relating to school safety, for completion of required reporting, and for completion of required training.

Specifically, this amendment will clarify reporting and documentation of threat assessments, including where no threat is found. In addition, amendments will address duties of the school safety specialist to ensure all school personnel receive youth mental health awareness training. Districts must submit district and charter school policies and written procedures pertaining to health, safety, and welfare of students to the Office of Safe Schools by July 1 of each year.
