



Annual Certification of Youth Mental Health Awareness Training

Each school district must certify to the Florida Department of Education (FDOE) that at least 80 percent of school personnel have received Youth Mental Health Awareness Training.

The number and percentage of trained school personnel must be calculated based upon the job codes or categories provided by FDOE each February 1, pursuant to Rule 6A-1.094120(4)(a), F.A.C., unless another method of identifying school personnel has been approved for the district by the Department. Each school district must implement procedures to include school personnel at charter schools in the district's certification. A school district may rely upon a charter school's certification without independent verification when submitting this certification.

In accordance with the requirements of section 1012.584(5), F.S., and Rule 6A-1.094120, F.A.C., I certify, that at least 80 percent of school personnel have completed Youth Mental Health Awareness Training.
