EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

This rule identifies the instrument to be used for VPK pre- and post-assessment, who can administer the instrument and training required for assessors.

During the 2021 legislative session, House Bill (HB) 419 was passed creating Section 1002.68, Florida Statutes, and establishing the Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring Program. Beginning in the 2022-2023 program year, all VPK programs must implement the new Coordinated Screening and Progress Monitoring assessment, which replaced the previously required VPK pre- and post-assessment.

This rule is being repealed as the VPK pre- and post-assessment is no longer required.
