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**Approval of Amendments to
Rules 6A-5.065, 6A-5.069, 6A-10.081 and 6A-7.0710, F.A.C.**

**State Board of Education

Rules 6A-5.065 and 6A-10.081, F.A.C.

- The amendments to these rules will prohibit educators from providing classroom instruction to students in kindergarten through grade 3 on sexual orientation or gender identity, as well as protect all students by expanding the definition of discrimination to include subjecting students to training or instruction that espouses, promotes, advances, inculcates, or compels any of the concepts listed in Section 1000.05(4)(a), F.S.
- The purpose of proposed Rule 6A-5.065, F.A.C., Florida Educator Accomplished Practices (FEAPs), is to align the Educator Accomplished Practices with new statutory requirements outlined in House Bills 7 and 1557 (2022).
- The purpose of proposed Rule 6A-10.081, F.A.C., Principles of Professional Conduct for the Education Profession, is to align the principles to statutory requirements outlined in House Bills 7 and 1557 (2022).

Rules 6A-5.069 and 6A-7.0710, F.A.C.

- The purpose of proposed Rule 6A-5.069, F.A.C., Professional Learning (PL) Systems, is to align the incorporated PL System template with new statutory requirements outlined in House Bill 7 (2022).
- The purpose of proposed Rule 6A-7.0710, F.A.C., Instructional Materials Evaluation Procedures, is to align publisher and reviewer assurances to statutory requirements outlined in House Bill 7 (2022), and enhance reviewer quality.



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
