**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

The purpose of the proposed amendment is to modify Rule 6A-14.064, Florida Administrative Code, so that it aligns with recent statutory changes. Specifically, the proposed amendment will authorize the use of alternative placement methods at Florida College System institutions for determining student eligibility for dual enrollment consistent with the changes made by Senate Bill 366 (2021). Additionally, reference to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges will be removed and revised pursuant to House Bill 7044 (2022). Lastly, an outdated reference to FACTS.org will be removed.
