PCPS Academic Progress Summary 2021-2022

3rd Grade Reading

- 50 (or 60%) of 84 eligible elementary schools saw a decline in the number of students reading at level 1
 - 12 schools had a double-digit decrease in the number of students reading at level 1
 - 11 schools saw a 5-9% point decrease in the number of students reading at level 1
- 40 (or 48%) of 84 eligible elementary schools saw an improvement in the number of students reading at level 3
 - 15 schools had a double-digit increase in the number of students reading at level 3
 - 13 schools saw a 5-9% point increase in the number of students reading at level 3.
 - 6 schools had no change in the student's reading at level 3



School Grade Summary

- 7 schools earned an A grade an improvement of four from the prior year
- 12 schools earned a B grade an improvement of five from the prior year
- 63 schools earned a C grade an improvement of twenty from the prior year
- The number of D schools was reduced by more than 57% going from 42 D schools in 20-21 to 18 D schools in 21-22.
- The number of F schools was reduced by more than 87.5% going from 8 F schools in 20-21 to just 1 F school in 21-22. (all F schools in 20-21 improved their grade)
 - 5 F schools improved their grade to a C
 - 3 F schools improved their grade to a D
- Three schools improved their grade from a B to an A
- One school improved its grade from a C to an A
- Seven schools improved their grade from a C to a B
- One school improved its grade from a D to a B
- 25 D schools improved their grades to a C
- The number of D and F schools declined by more than 62 %
- 7 (50%) of 14 schools under state oversight due to persistent low performance will exit this status due to their significant improvement

District Managed Turnaround Plans include unified comprehensive support as shown below:

- Additional interventions above what may be already offered in Reading, Math and Science at other schools;
- Extended day for additional benchmark planning time for teachers twice per week (MOU);
- Quarterly instructional reviews
- Routine scheduling audits
- HR specialist with priority on teacher recruitment and placement at TOP schools;
- New and Novice Principal and Assistant Principal Mentorship Program
- DataCom (formerly District-Based Leadership Team) meetings with Superintendent and Cabinet
- Weekly oversight from Regional Superintendent and/or Senior Directors
- VAM Teacher Support Plans
- Individualized School Improvement Plans focusing on specific needs and action plans for each school
