**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

In accordance with section 1004.0981, Florida Statutes, the attached policy regarding the awarding of postsecondary credit or clock hours for law enforcement training in Florida is presented to the State Board of Education (SBOE) for approval.

The policy was developed by the Statewide Workgroup for Law Enforcement Training and adopted by the Articulation Coordinating Committee (ACC) as required by s. 1004.0981, F.S. The policy establishes a statewide process for prioritizing and determining postsecondary course equivalencies and the minimum postsecondary credit or career education clock hours that must be awarded for law enforcement training and experience.

Upon approval, the ACC will implement this process to facilitate the review of law enforcement training and experience and will approve a prioritized list of course equivalencies, which will be brought to the SBOE and the Board of Governors of the State University System of Florida on an annual basis.
