Definition	
<p>A ten-character code used to uniquely identify a student. The number must be maintained for all adult general education students.</p> <p>If the student provides a social security number, the Student Number Identifier equals the social security number followed by an "X."</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">NNNNNNNNNX Example: 123456789X</p> <p>If a student does not provide a social security number, The CBO should assign a number using the common statewide method.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">First Three Digits</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">NNN                      For any student entering for the first time who does not have a social security number, the first three digits will represent the CBO.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">Last Seven Digits</p> <p style="padding-left: 80px;">NNNNNNN            The last seven digits are CBO-defined in such a way as to result in a unique student number within the CBO where the number is originally assigned.</p> <p>Note: Request a social security number for each Adult student who enrolls or who is enrolled in classes. However, a student is not required to provide his or her social security number as a condition for enrollment or graduation.</p>
