

Rule 6A-10.0315, F.A.C., Demonstration of Readiness for College-Level Communication and Computation



Rule 6A-10.0315, Florida Administrative Code Classic Learning Test Update

- During the 2023 legislative session, HB 1537 passed which expanded options for students by adding the Classic Learning Test (CLT) as an additional assessment option for high school students to satisfy graduation requirements. The bill was signed into law and is effective July 1, 2023.
- The purpose of the amendment to Rule 6A-10.0315, F.A.C., is to expand access to postsecondary education by adding a new option for students to demonstrate college readiness for:
 - Dual enrollment eligibility for secondary students.
 - Developmental education exemption for returning adult students.
 - Course placement.
- The amendment adds the CLT and standard scores, which are based on concordant SAT and ACT scores, as a fifth common placement test option for students and institutions to use.
