 The school hosts at least one of the following annual military recognition events: Month of the Military Child, Month of the Military Family, Purple-Up! For Military Kids!, Veteran's Day, Memorial Day;

2. through 6. No change.

(4) Application and renewal.

(a) <u>Schools</u> Beginning with the 2022-23 school year, a school that meets the criteria for the <u>Florida</u> Purple Star School of Distinction Designation must report the information listed in subsection (3) of this rule to the Department of Education by completing the Purple Star School of Distinction Application form, PSDA-1,
