**Approval of Amendment to Rule 6A-2.0020, F.A.C.,
Eligibility for Charter School Capital Outlay**

2022-23 Charter School Statistics

- 381,184 students served
- 726 charter schools
 - 45% of schools achieved an “A” grade.
 - 22% of schools received a “B” grade.

Eligibility for Charter School Capital Outlay

- The amendment:
 - Increases transparency and accountability;
 - Changes eligibility requirements for charter school capital outlay funding; and
 - Brings the rule into alignment with legislative changes made in HB 1537 and HB 1259.

Eligibility for Charter School Capital Outlay

- The rule amendment makes changes to the charter school capital outlay funding eligibility to:
 - Prohibit capital outlay funding eligibility for a charter school that receives two consecutive grades of "F," three consecutive grades below "C," or two consecutive school improvement ratings of "Unsatisfactory;"
 - Remove previous capital outlay funding eligibility standards stated in rule;
 - Provide edits to incorporated forms to address legislative changes and to improve clarity.
