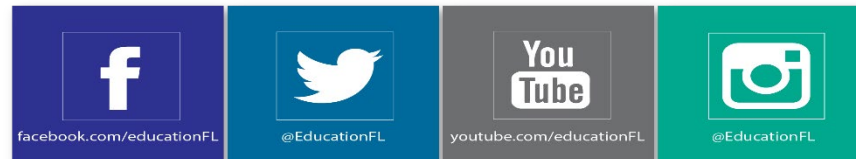
Rule 6A-1.09991, F.A.C., Collegiate Purple Star Campuses

- Senate Bill 732 establishes the Collegiate Purple Star Campus program which recognizes Florida College System institutions and school district career centers that demonstrate a commitment to supporting military families.
- The proposed new rule outlines the criteria to receive the purple star campus designation and the application process.
- Military students will see a variety of benefits at these institutions, including:
 - Early registration, and
 - Additional access to resources at FCS institutions and career centers.
- Institutions receiving the designation will hold it for three years, after which they can renew with the same form and requirements.
