EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of new Rule 6A-14.0810, Florida Administrative Code, is to implement Chapter 2023-184, Laws of Florida, which requires Florida College System institutions to have a supply of emergency opioid antagonists in each of the residence halls and dormitory residences they own or operate. The new rule applies only to Florida College System institutions with housing owned or operated by the school, but other institutions with housing provided by a direct support organization may also provide emergency opioid antagonists in their student housing, as long as they follow this rule. The new rule clarifies language and defines terms "administer," "administration," "emergency opioid antagonist," and "Institution housing." The rule also outlines policies and procedures and provides guidance on the location of and administration of the opioid antagonists.
