EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The 2022 Legislature created the Charter School Review Commission within the Department of Education. The Commission will have the same power and duties as other charter school sponsors regarding the review and approval of charter schools. The Commission shall consist of seven members who have charter school experience, selected by the State Board of Education and subject to confirmation by the Senate. The Commissioner of Education shall designate one member as the chair. Each member shall be appointed to a four-year term. However, for the purpose of achieving staggered terms, of the initial appointments, three members shall be appointed to two-year terms and four members shall be appointed for four-year terms. All subsequent appointments shall be for four-year terms.
