**EMERGENCY ORDER**


WHEREAS, approximately 50,000 Florida educators have now benefitted from the waiver of the registration fees for nearly 100,000 Florida Teacher Certification Examinations, provided for in Rule 6A-4.0021, Florida Administrative Code, realizing a total savings of nearly \$13 million since this waiver of fees was issued on March 23, 2020.

NOW THEREFORE, the waiver of the registration fees for Florida Teacher Certification Examinations, established by section 8.B. of DOE Order No. 2020-EO-01, is ended effective May 19, 2020. Beginning on May 20, 2020, the registration fees for Florida Teacher Certification Examinations, provided for in Rule 6A-4.0021, Florida Administrative Code, are fully reinstated.
