


# District Secondary Career and Technical Education State Summary, 2009-10

## Part 1: Students Enrolled in Secondary Job Preparatory Programs

According to section 1003.01(4)(b), Florida Statutes, job preparatory programs offer “instruction in the competencies that prepare students for effective entry into an occupation, including diversified cooperative education, work experience, and job-entry programs that coordinate directed study and on-the-job training.”

### Four-Year Job Preparatory Program Enrollment Trend





## Part 2: Career and Technical Education Concentrators

Definition: **CTE concentrators** are secondary students who have earned at least three credits in a single CTE program.<sup>1</sup>

According to section 1003.493, Florida Statutes, Career and Professional Academies are research-based programs that integrate a rigorous academic curriculum with an industry-specific curriculum aligned directly to priority workforce needs established by regional workforce boards.


