SUBJECT: Gen Ed Digital Badge

As mentioned during the councils meeting last week, the Division is partnering with the Office of Board of Governors on developing the processes and procedures around the general education digital badge. The attached resource guide contains preliminary implementation steps to inform your planning. Please note this is a <u>working document</u> and may be subject to change as the faculty committees come together over the next few weeks.
