SUBJECT: Approval of Amendment to Rule 6A-14.064, College Credit Dual Enrollment

On October 20, 2022, the State Board of Education approved revisions to Rule 6A-14.064, Florida Administrative Code, College Credit Dual Enrollment. This amendment is in accordance with section (s.) 1008.30, Florida Statutes (F.S.), as amended by Senate Bill 366 (2021), which authorizes the use of alternative placement methods for determining student eligibility for dual enrollment at Florida College System institutions. The amendment also removes reference to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges per s. 1008.47, F.S., and removes an obsolete reference to FACTS.org. A copy of the rule is attached for your reference.

Action Required

Florida College System institutions are authorized to use alternative placement methods in lieu of or in addition to a common placement test when determining student eligibility to participate in dual enrollment. Any college that elects to incorporate alternative placement methods into its dual enrollment eligibility policy must outline the provisions of that policy in the institution's dual enrollment articulation agreements. We encourage you to implement these options for the benefit of students and work closely with your school district(s) to implement them with fidelity.
