




2016-17 General Revenue Funds Operations and Fixed Capital Outlay =\$30.3 billion




Total Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) Funding by Source (K-12)






Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) Funding per FTE by Source (K-12)






District Workforce Education: Total Funds by Source





District Workforce Education: Total Funds per FTE Student by Source






The Florida College System Program Fund Appropriations by Source Lower and Upper Levels Combined

Budget Guidelines

- 1. Provide continuation funding, including the replacement of nonrecurring funds, for items that meet at least one of the following criteria:
 - a. Constitutional requirements
 - b. Statutory requirements
 - c. Supports the State Board of Education and Commissioner's Priorities
 - d. Alignment with Governor Scott's Priority Initiatives
- 2. Include no change in 2016-17 millage rates, tuition or fees.
- 3. Use the most currently available consensus estimating conference data to provide enrollment-based funding adjustments based on 2016-17 appropriated funding levels, including performance-based and declining enrollment adjustments.
- 4. Develop a fixed capital outlay budget in accordance with statutory requirements and consensus revenue estimates of available cash.






K-12 FTE Enrollment Historical and Forecasted




The Florida College System FTE Enrollment Historical and Forecasted Lower and Upper Levels Combined





Florida Education Finance Program (FEFP) Tax Roll (K-12)








General Revenue Forecast





Educational Enhancement Trust Fund Revenue Outlook


Lottery Ticket Sales and Slot Machine Activity





State School Trust Fund Revenue Outlook


Estimated Transfers from Unclaimed Property TF
