## MEMORANDUM

**TO:** Publishers of Instructional Materials

**FROM:** Dr. Eric J. Smith, Commissioner

**DATE:** January 12, 2009

**SUBJECT:** Announcement of the 2009-2010 Instructional Materials Adoption

The Florida Department of Education has announced its plans for the 2009-2010 instructional materials adoption and is calling for bids in Mathematics, K-12.

Intents to bid must be submitted no later than 11:59 p.m., Eastern Standard Time (EST), February 27, 2009. Bids must be filed in the Instructional Materials Office of the Florida Department of Education no later than 5:00 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time (EDT), May 4, 2009. Resulting contracts shall be for a six-year period effective April 1, 2010.

The Florida adoption is limited to instructional materials that meet the definition of “major tool” and accompanying “ancillary materials” as follows:

“Major tool” refers to:

- Materials that provide instructional content and student learning activities for each of the Next Generation Sunshine State Standards (NGSSS) benchmarks that are in the course descriptions for mathematics;
- Materials that provide instructional content and student learning activities for each of the intended outcomes and/or student performance standards of the Career and Technical Education Curriculum Frameworks;
- Materials that provide instructional content and student learning activities for the course objectives as outlined by the appropriate organizations for Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and Advanced International Certificate of Education.
