<p><b>Monday, January 25</b></p>	<p>Introduction video to literacy week with read aloud, How to Read a Book by Kwame Alexander Intro video to day 1 read aloud and activity Read aloud video: I Can Write the World by Joshunda Sanders Activity: Students write about what they can do to make a difference in their communities or the world and post their response on their grade level's Padlet.</p>

<p><b>Thursday, January 28</b></p>	<p>Intro video to day 4 read aloud and activity Read aloud video: Fry Bread by Kevin Noble Maillard Activity: Students will write about foods that are important to their families or communities and tell how and why certain foods became important.
