<p><i>Monday, January 25</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Beta Club literacy fact posters will be displayed around the school. • Parent Read Aloud- Parents will record themselves reading and share it with the teacher to play for the students in class. • Teachers will post a picture of themselves reading a favorite book.
<p><i>Tuesday, January 26</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will write a letter of appreciation to a student, teacher, or staff member. • Students will receive a prize when they are caught reading around school. • Famous Quote/Biography Dress-Up Day- Students will dress in the attire of a person who has positively influenced our world. They will include the quote or book title with their outfit.
<p><i>Wednesday, January 27</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Dictionary Day- Students will choose a word from the dictionary (with the theme of “Humanity Tells a Story”) and dress up as that word. The students will have the word and definition attached to their outfit. • Students will receive a candy prize as they check out books. • Teachers will post videos of themselves reading a book on social media so that students can view the read aloud at home.
