

<p>Monday, January 24th</p>	<p>Present all students who have read one million words or more on ITV. ITV crew recites the Reader’s Oath. Students will read throughout the week to meet the 10-book challenge goal set up at the beginning of each quarter. Research a planet or interesting/favorite place using World Book Online, Encyclopedia Online and/or book resources and present fun facts to the class during the week.</p>
<p>Tuesday, January 25th</p>	<p>Teachers will be “guest readers” to other classes or their pod mates.</p>
<p>Wednesday, January 26th</p>	<p>Reading is Snow Much Fun! Read-A-Thon in pajamas</p>
<p>Thursday, January 27th</p>	<p>Create a Reading Book Worm by allowing students to sit back-to-back forming a long “book worm” and read this way for 15 minutes. This can be done by class or by grade level pod.</p>
<p>Friday, January 28th</p>	<p>10-Book Challenge – Students who met this goal will be announced on ITV. Students share the fun facts they read about a planet or favorite place they researched on Monday. Sometimes research takes longer, so we’ve given students all week to gather their fun facts!</p>
