**Introduction:** This year, our Celebrate Literacy Week, Florida! theme is Launch into Literacy, Blast Off into New Worlds!


With this theme in mind, students will read books with a variety of settings to show that reading can take us ANYWHERE!

Read Aloud: The Magician's Hat by Malcolm Mitchell






**“Reading is Out of this World”**




**“Stories are Told Around the Campfire”** Read


**“Music Can Change the World”**
