Monday, January 24th



Launch yourself into a good book!
Post literacy quotes & posters around school.

Teachers joyfully read aloud to each of their classes (favorite book or chapter, current event, primary source, etc.) and discuss what disciplinary literacy looks like in their course.

Thank the teachers for promoting disciplinary literacy as experts in their course content! (Mars, Milky Way, Starburst etc. themed candy, galaxy punch)
*Promote the week's ideas on your school news program and through daily announcements.

Tuesday, January 25th



Rings around a good book! Students write the name of their favorite book on one side of a strip of colored paper and a summary or a statement about why it was their favorite book on the other side and make a literacy chain.
Content area teachers may prepare for T-Shirt tomorrow.

Wednesday, January 26th



Reading is a Blast! Wear a literacy-themed T-shirt.
Can give themed treats to those participating.

All content area teachers are involved in creating shirts with idioms or puns of their content area or course.

Thursday, January 27th



Be a Shining Star with a book! Dress as a favorite book character.

Friday, January 28th



Read Under the Sun! Students may wear sunglasses and classes may read outside on a beach towel with their teachers.
