<p>Monday, January 24th</p>	<p>Million Minute Marathon kick off district wide.</p> <p>Elementary: Students decorate doors of the classroom based on a book representing a place in the world.</p> <p>Middle: Bell Work task – making inferences and preferences based on book covers. Positive Affirmation cut outs to hide in library books</p> <p>High: Students create one pagers about a book they are reading some of which will decorate halls.</p>
<p>Tuesday, January 25th</p>	<p>Elementary: "Wear Red...Be Well Read"</p> <p>Middle: First author interview and video with discussion guide and book giveaway. Door or Book Cover Decorating Contest</p> <p>High: Teachers allow 10 minutes to "Blast Off" with a book. Students replace bell work with free reading time in their classrooms.</p>
<p>Wednesday, January 26th</p>	<p>Elementary: "Reading Rocks so Wear Your Funky Socks"</p> <p>Middle: Second author interview and video with discussion guide and book giveaway. Character Dress up Day</p> <p>High: Staff post "What I am Reading" signs outside their classroom doors</p>
<p>Thursday, January 27th</p>	<p>Elementary: "Score with Books" Students wear their favorite team gear.</p> <p>Middle: Third author interview and video with discussion guide and book giveaway. Favorite Book and Why Graffiti Wall</p> <p>High: Read aloud- ELA teachers read the short story, "All Summer in a Day" and have an out of this world discussion.</p>
<p>Friday, January 28th</p>	<p>Million Minute Marathon (last day)</p> <p>Elementary: "Be a Reading Rock Star" Dress up like a rock star.</p> <p>Middle: Favorite things in books partner share activity. Staff Member read favorite picture book on morning show.</p> <p>High: "Dress the Part" dress up day. Students pick a favorite book character and dress up like that character.</p>
