<p>Monday, January 24th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “Countdown to Success”- School-wide reading goal will be shared and students will sign the displayed CLW Reader’s Oath. • Students will take selfies with their favorite books to be featured on the school news. • Students will donate a book for a book exchange and get a prize.
<p>Tuesday, January 25th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will write about their favorite book on a rocket template. • Morning book talks will be shown on the news. • Each building will be assigned a different country to read about over the course of the week.
<p>Wednesday, January 26th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Blast off to a new world- Dress up as your favorite storybook character. • An audio clip of a teacher reading a poem will be played on the news. Classes will call to guess who the mystery reader is. • Book giveaways will occur during lunch with the opportunity for students to take pictures with their books in a photobooth.
<p>Thursday, January 27th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Picnics and Paperbacks- During lunch, parents can join their child to read and eat outside. • Parent literacy night tied to the week’s theme. • Individual photos of staff reading books will be displayed on the news.
<p>Friday, January 28th</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will learn new vocabulary while participating in the vocabulary parade. • A door decorating contest tied to the theme, “Launching Into Literacy” will be held. • High school students will read with students at the neighboring elementary school.
