#### Florida's Private Schools


A private school is defined in Section 1002.01(2), Florida Statutes, as "an individual, association, copartnership, or corporation or department, division, or section of such organizations, that designates itself as an educational center that includes kindergarten or a higher grade" and is below the college level. Private elementary and secondary schools in Florida are not licensed, approved, accredited, or regulated by the Florida Department of Education. Private schools are required by statute to complete an annual online survey to gather information for inclusion in a statewide **Directory of Private Schools**.

The **Directory of Private Schools** is maintained by the Department of Education as a service to the public, to governmental agencies, and to other parties that are interested in obtaining information about Florida private schools. The Department's intent in maintaining the directory is not to regulate, control, approve or accredit private schools. As such, the accuracy of data submitted pursuant to the annual online survey and inclusion of a school's information in the directory is not verified by the Department and does not imply approval or accreditation. 
The 2005-2006 annual report contains student enrollment and information for private schools that completed the online annual survey between July 1, 2005 and August 23, 2006. The following points are noted from the data contained in this report:

- Private school enrollment in Florida in 2005-2006 appears to have decreased by approximately 4% from the 2004-2005 school year. This apparent decrease may be a result of a change in the Department's annual survey reporting methodology rather than an actual decease in the number of operating private schools and enrolled students. The Department has initiated increased technical assistance to private schools in an effort to communicate the importance of following appropriate annual survey procedures.
- Of the 350,287 students enrolled in private schools in Florida in 2005-2006, 14% were enrolled in prekindergarten, 61% were enrolled in elementary grades (kindergarten through grade eight), 21% were enrolled in secondary grades (grades nine through twelve) and about 4% were enrolled as multigraded and other type students.
- Of Florida's total PK-12 student enrollment in 2005-2006, 88% were public school students and 12% were private school students.
- Twenty (20) school districts had 10% or more of their total PK-12 students enrolled in private schools in 2005-2006.
- Almost 83% of personnel employed in private schools were classroom teachers and 17% were school administrators in 2005-2006.

## Number of Private Schools 1994-2006




## Private School Enrollment 1994-2006





### Private School Instructional and Administrative Personnel 2005-2006

The reported personnel data are based on the Private School Data Base Survey on seven personnel types: pre-k teacher, kindergarten teacher, elementary teacher (grades 1-6), secondary teacher (grades 7-12), librarian and media specialist, guidance personnel, and administrator. Support personnel such as secretaries, aides, paraprofessionals, and volunteers are not included. Statistics for personnel in the named areas reflect actual numbers of such individuals but do not indicate the full range of duties they may perform. Reporting instructions requested that full-time employees who have responsibilities in more than one area be reported in the category where they spend the majority of their time.
