## STUDENT DISCIPLINE/RESULTANT ACTION – REJECT RULES

- 
6. The Discipline/Resultant Action Code must be alphabetic and must be C, E, F, H, I, L, M, N, O, P, R, S or U. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The third record listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause its rejection. The first two records below would be rejected because the Discipline/Resultant Action code is invalid.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Florida Education Identifier	Discipline/Resultant Action Code
* 40	FL123456789100	B
* 40	FL123456789200	W
40	FL123456789300	C

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected records should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the database, the district should correct the Discipline/Resultant Action Code and resubmit the records.

## STUDENT DISCIPLINE/RESULTANT ACTION – REJECT RULES



17. If the Discipline/Resultant Action code is C L, M, N or R, then Duration, Discipline Action must be zero. -record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The first and third records listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second record would be rejected because the Duration, Discipline Action is greater than zero.

District Number, Current Enrollment	Florida Education Identifier	Discipline/ Resultant Action Code	Duration, Discipline Action
36	FL123456789100	C	000
* 36	FL123456789200	C	010
36	FL123456789300	E	090

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Duration, Discipline Action or the Discipline/Resultant Action Code and resubmit the record.

## SCHOOL ENVIRONMENTAL SAFETY INCIDENT REPORT – REJECT RULES

11. Incident, Reported to Law Enforcement code must be A, C, D, I, L, M, Y or N.  
-record rejected-

### EXAMPLE

The first two records listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The third record would be rejected because the Incident, Reported to Law Enforcement code is not a valid code.

District Number, Where Incident Occurred	School Number, Where Incident Occurred	Incident, Identifier	Incident, Reported to Law Enforcement
01	0271	VT000001	<del>Y</del> D
01	0271	AR000002	N
* 01	0271	BE000003	Z

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected record to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Incident, Reported to Law Enforcement code and resubmit the record.
