**DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY**

The district must verify that the student took an Advanced Placement (AP) course. If the student did not take an AP course, then the district must correct the FTE Earned: College Entrance Examination Board Advanced Placement Test **or FTE Earned, College Board Advanced Placement Capstone Diploma** amount on the Student Additional Funding record.

## INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION – REJECT RULES

11. If Course Number equals 0000000 and Grade Level is KG-08, then the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code must be zero.

If Course Number begins with a number; and

Is a course number from the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730); other than 0000000, 1006300, 2000350, 2000360, 2102360, 2102365, 2102370, 3027010, or 3027020;

Then the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code must be a valid program number (Supplemental Indicator at position 20 not equal 'A') for the Course Number submitted, as listed in file F61730 for School Year - Course Taken.

If the Course Number begins with three alphabetic characters followed by a zero in the fourth position, and

Is a course number from the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730);

Then the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code must be a valid program number for the Course Number submitted, as listed in file F61730 for School Year - Course Taken.

If Course Number begins with one alphabetic character followed by a numeric digit, and

Is a course number from the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730);

Then the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code (Supplemental Indicator at position 20 not equal 'A') must be the same as the Course Number for School Year - Course Taken.

### EXAMPLE

The first and, second, ~~and third~~ records listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The ~~fourth~~ third record would be rejected because the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code is not a valid program number.

### **DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY**

If the rejected record should not have been submitted, no action is required. However, if the district wishes the data in the rejected records to be loaded to the database, the district must correct the Career and Technical/Adult General Education Program Code and resubmit the record.

## INDUSTRY CERTIFICATION – STATE VALIDATION RULES

41. If Course Number begins with a number and school year-course taken = school year-record submitted; and

- Is a course number from the Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Edit file (F61730) for the School Year – Course Taken; and
- Is not 000000, 1006300, 2000350, 2000360, 2102360, 2102365, 2102370, 3027010, or 3027020;

Then there must be a matching record on the Career and Technical Education Student Course Schedule format based on Florida Education Identifier; District Number, Current Instruction; School Number, Current Instruction; Survey Period Code; Career and Technical Education/Adult General Education Program Code; Course Number; School Year - Record Submitted. – state validation -

### EXAMPLE

The first and second Industry Certification records listed below would pass this edit. However, the third and fourth Industry Certification records would fail this edit because there are no matching Career and Technical Education Student Course Schedule records.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must delete the Industry Certification records if they were submitted in error or submit Career and Technical Education Student Course Schedule records that match on the indicated fields.

## STUDENT ADDITIONAL FUNDING – STATE VALIDATION RULES

40. If FTE Earned, Early graduates is greater than zero, then a Student End of Year Status record must exist and the Diploma Type on the Student End of Year Status record must be W06, **WCO**, WFT, or WRW. The records should match based on District Number, Current Enrollment; Florida Education Identifier; Survey Period, and Year.

### EXAMPLE

The second and third records would cause a message to be generated because the FTE Earned, Early Graduates is greater than zero and the Diploma Type codes are not W06, WFT or WRW.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY

The district must review the Diploma Type codes and the FTE Earned, Early Graduates amounts and correct the items that are in error. The district must then resubmit the records.

## STUDENT ADDITIONAL FUNDING – EXCEPTION REPORTS

 **62.** If FTE Earned, College Entrance Examination Board Advanced Placement Test or FTE Earned, College Board Advanced Placement Capstone Diploma is greater than zero, and

- If District Number, Current Instruction/Service equals 01-68, or 72-75, then the student must have a Student Course Schedule record with a course number that matches a course identified in the Course Code Directory (AP\_) as an Advanced Placement (AP) course in Surveys 2 or 3 of the current school year, or
- If District Number, Current Instruction/Service equals 71 and School Number, Current Instruction Service equals 0300 or 0400 or 0801, then the student must have a Student Course Schedule record with a course number that matches a course identified in the Course Code Directory (AP\_) as an Advanced Placement (AP) course in Surveys 2, 3 or 4 of the current school year, or
- If District Number, Current Instruction is equal to 71 and School Number, Current Instruction/Service equal 0500 or, 0600, then the student must have a Student Course Schedule record with a course number that matches a course identified in the Course Code Directory (AP\_) as an Advanced Placement (AP) course in Surveys 1, 2, 3, or 4 of the current school year.
- The District Number, Current Instruction/Service, School Number, Current Instruction/Service, Year, and Florida Education Identifier (FLEID) on the Student Additional Funding format must match the Student Course Schedule format ~~for Survey 2 or 3 records only~~record.

### EXAMPLE

The first record listed below would pass this edit. The second record would not pass the edit because the FTE Earned: College Entrance Examination Board (CEEB) Advanced Placement Test is greater than zero and the student does not have a Student Course Schedule record with a course number identified in the Course Code Directory for AP course in Surveys 2 or 3 of the current school year.
