The standard FTE generated if the student is not enrolled in an early college program, but completes a general education core course through the dual enrollment program with a grade of "A" or better is 0.08. The standard FTE generated in a career dual enrollment course as identified by the Department of Education with a grade "A" or better is 0.08.

Two decimal places are assumed to the right of the decimal. (s. 1011.62, F.S.)

008	Standard FTE generated is 0.08 if the student completes a career course through a dual enrollment program with a grade of "A" in a pathway that leads to an industry certification that is included on the CAPE Industry Certification Funding List.
016	Standard FTE generated is 0.16 if the student is enrolled in an early college program and completes a general education core course through the dual enrollment program with a grade of "A" or better. (decimal places are assumed)

## STUDENT ADDITIONAL FUNDING – REJECT RULES



21. FTE Earned, ~~Academic~~-Dual Enrollment Course must be numeric and must equal 0.00, 0.08, 0.16, 0.24, 0.32, 0.40, 0.48, 0.56, 0.64, 0.72, 0.80, 0.88, 0.96, 1.04, 1.12, 1.28, 1.44, 1.60, 1.76, or 1.92. -record rejected-

**NOTE:** Two decimal places assumed.

### EXAMPLE

The first and fourth records listed below would be loaded to the database assuming no other reject rule would cause their rejection. The second and third records listed below would be rejected. The second record would be rejected because FTE Earned, ~~Academic~~-Dual Enrollment Course is not numeric. The third record would be rejected because FTE Earned, ~~Academic~~-Dual Enrollment Course is not valid.

### DISTRICT RESPONSIBILITY
